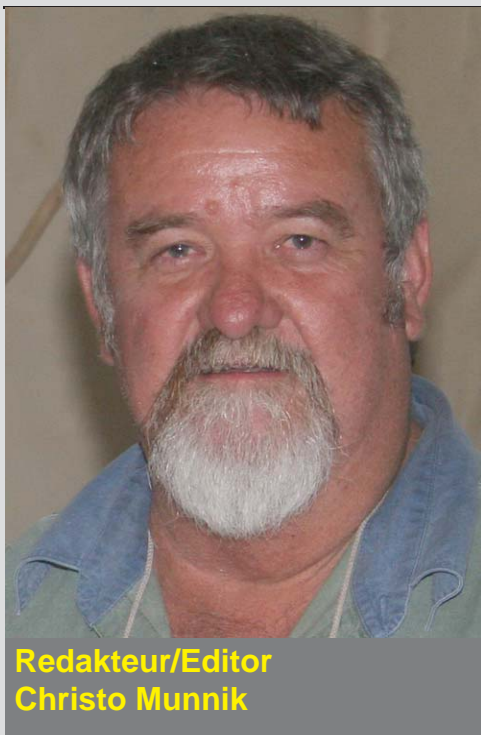

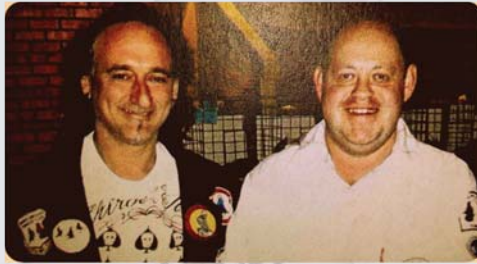


Bloemfontein 4 July 2018

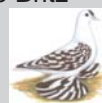

Hy is wel verlam, maar beslis nie lamsakkig

Met vergunning van Stefan de Villiers van "Die Laevelder" WITRIVIER

"Hy het miskien sy nek gebreek, maar my man het ruggraat." Só sê die 32 jaar lange eggenoot van 'n kwadrupleeg, Simon Jordaan, wat sedert 'n ongeluk op die ouderdom van 20 verlam is.

Simon het tydens 'n ontspanningsessie in 1981, by 'n oord naby Pelindaba in Gauteng in die bodem van 'n swembad vasgeduik en sy nek gebreek. Strydig met wat 'n mens sou verwag, het hy na die ongeluk "begin lewe". "Ek het gelewe vir die wêreld en wat gebeur as die wêreld jou klaar gebruik het? Hy spoeg jou uit," sê Simon.

Hy was 'n kranige stoeier en in sy Noord-Transvaalse kleure het iemand hom om elke hoek en draai begroet. "Ek het gedink ek het vriende," vertel Simon. "Maar waar was hulle die dag toe ek my ver-

moë om te beweeg verloor het? Hulle het langs my by die swembad gestaan waar ek hulpeloos gelê het en vir my gesê ek moet opstaan. Maar ek kon nie. Drie dae later het ek wakker geword, en hulle was weg. En dit is hoekom jy nie vir ander mense of vir die wêreld moet lewe nie," vertel hy. Hy weier dat dít hom onderkry.

Simon en sy vrou Susann bly in harmonie saam by 'n kleinhoewe skuins voor Karula Hotel op die R538 Yaverland-pad. Met Laevelder se aankoms op 'n koue Saterdagmiddag bied die joernalis aan om die ou inhakhek oop te maak, maar nee... In sy elektriese rolstoel, dik in wintersklere getooi, maak Simon op sy aangepaste manier die hek sonder sukkel oop - wat indrukwekkend is, aangesien sy beweging in sy arms tot sy gewigte beperk is, en hy glad nie sy hande

toe kan maak nie.

“Ek sit in ‘n rolstoel, maar die lewe hou my nie op nie - ek lewe,” sê hy. Behalwe vir sy treffende versameling duiwe, doen hy ook sweiswerk, en glo dit of nie, hy is ook ‘n platejoggie. Sy vrou sê sy het nog nooit so ‘n positiewe mens ontmoet nie, en sou geen ander lewensmaat wou kies nie. “Al is hy van ander afhanklik, bly hy steeds die man van die huis. Hy hoef nie ja en amen te sê vir alles wat ek

sê nie,” sê sy. “As ons iewers heen ry, is hy die een wat steeds die bande moet nagaan, hy moet die olie check, hy moet sy eie klere pak,” sê sy, en terwyl ons in die buitelug sit waar Simon die meeste van sy tyd bestee, omring deur sy trots - smaraggroen “engelskouduiwe”, en ‘n tuin waarin jy jouself kan verloor, sê hy dít is wat die lewe interessant hou. “So lank jy lewe, maak die beste daarvan.”

Judging South African National Pigeon Show 4-6 July 2018

Well, let me start by saying thank you for inviting me to judge Tumblers at the South African National Pigeon Show. The last time I was in Africa was in 2010 and enjoyed my time on Safari and judging. I was eager to come back in 2014, however with my hips getting worse, I could not make the 2014 trip and ultimately had both hips done. Having decided that we once again planned another trip on Safari. Taking some friends along with me for their first time to Africa, we had an experience that no matter how many times you may go, is always different and exciting. We had a fantastic time.

Well, on with the show... Getting from Kruger with temperatures ranging from 26°C to 30°C was a warm welcome compared to Winter in Melbourne. In saying that, driving eight hours at the end of our trip to arrive in Bloemfontein with the night being -7°C

was a shock to the body and made me feel right at home. The next morning arriving early to the Poultry Pavilion was as cold as ice; two pairs of socks, two pairs of pants, three jumpers and a jacket seemed to do the trick; though my hands were like ice blocks. I had the pleasure of stewarding for Christo Britz in the morning which gave us an opportunity to warm up before judging Tumblers. Seeing Brad Turner from Australia there was also a pleasure as he judged Nuns, Fan-tails and Frills.

TUMBLERS: 70 Tumblers shown with a few classes consisting of 7 birds with tight competition.

Champion Marked Muffed Opalbar, disappointing to see only one showing. Quality wise, nice station smooth feather good top skull and eye placement. Though lacking in muffs, beak substance and long. Hopefully that Dr. Koot Serfontein keeps that line going.



Champion Marked Cleanlegged was a young Yellow Bald hen. Must be the best

yellow bald I have ever seen. Quality wise, was as good as most balds getting around. Condition was a little down, but an easy winner. Owned by Charl Naudé. Also a beautiful dun, with a nice team of balds shown.

Best Muffed was a Black old cock also owned by Charl Naudé. He was nice and short, smooth feather. Needed a little



more headpower and beak substance but the size a Tumbler should be. Strong powerful birds shown but all too big with no style or station. This is not what is required as a Tumbler. The Black Muffed also went on to be Reserve Champion of

show.

Clean legs approximately 40 shown with a mixture in types many had great heads but were long, tall and lacking style. In saying that there were some excellent classes, making me sweat a little to pick a champion. These birds were all similar and I knew that these were from the same family.

Champion Cleanlegged and overall Grand Champion was a small Brown Bar young hen owned by Christo Britz. This to me was a perfect Tumbler in all aspects. Short, cobby, power, beak, eye

placement, top skull- she had the lot. They have definitely improved from my last visit in 2010. These would compete anywhere in the world that I have seen on my travels.

SPECIAL MENTION: A nice Black Cleanlegged from Bertie Wessels. A very classy bird, had the lot almost but was put off by the length of legs. Lovely bird, but just not right. This Tumbler was pushing for best Cleanlegged against the brown bar but lost due to the length of legs.

CONCLUSION: From what I had shown in front of me, I can see that many Tumblers are getting too big, long and no style or station. This being more important in a Tumbler than having great head power only. These types are not what the standards call for. They need to be short, cobby and have station, as we all know,

days of head hunters are over I say.

Advice to the breeders is that there are some good quality Tumblers in South Africa and recommend possibly getting your hands on a few shorter birds and improve the bodies on your birds. In saying that there are great Tumblers getting around to breed outstanding Tumblers. We are all striving to do this and we all love the challenge no doubt.

Christo Britz's Tumblers were all stand-outs compared to others showing. Short, compact and powerful birds. Thank you for inviting me to judge as I really enjoyed myself, great birds, great people and great friends. I hope to be back in a few years, God willing, to see the progress made.
