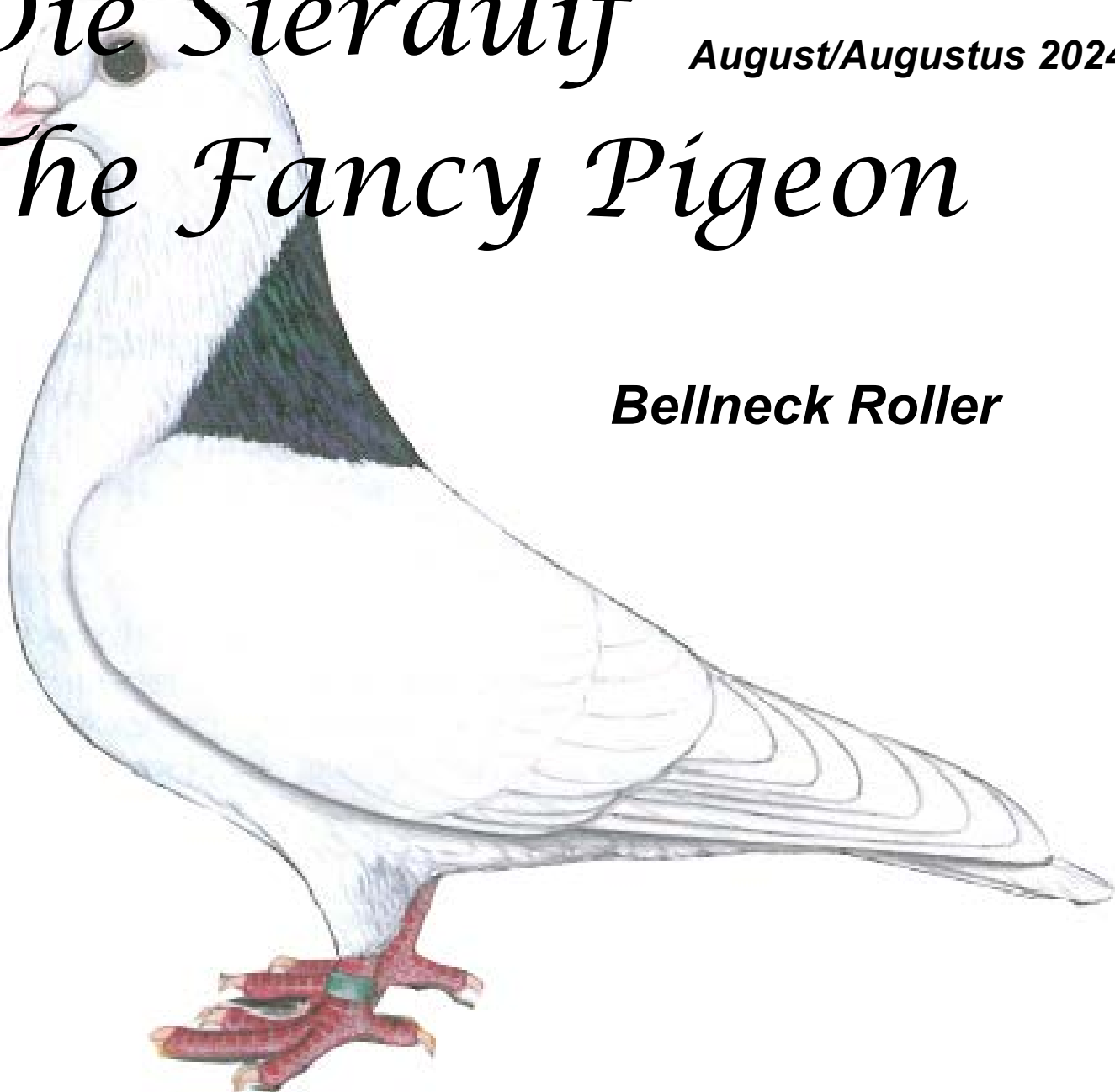

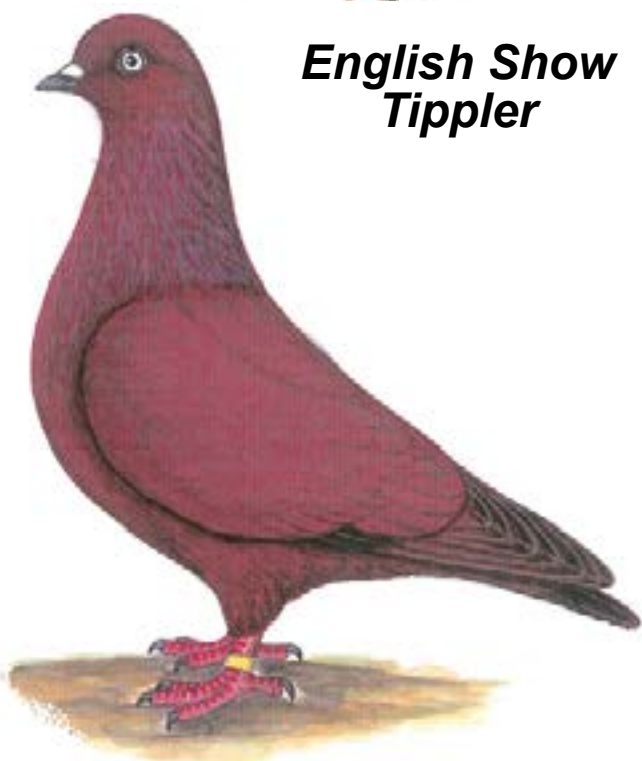

Netta and myself joined in 1994, we started with Frillbacks we later got two eggs from a friend of ours when hatched they turned out to be Capuchines of which one did very well at the SA's in Worcester 10927/95 was the no. then things started after that, we ended up with just over 2000 birds of which most were Rarebreed birds.

Our first SA's was in Worcester in 1996 that is when we got a whole lot of Ice Pigeons we build up a strong breed from them with many winners. We went to Bethlehem for a regional show there we got Cleanleg Ice Pigeons and Damacenes from an old man in Frankfort the birds had no rings on them.

In 1999 Netta was chosen as President of the EP region a post she held for 13 years at the same time I was treasurer for the region, during that time two SA's was put on 2004 and 2008. At the 2008 SA's

Netta was elected as the Ringmaster, in 2012 she gave up the post of President to put all her time to the Ringmaster post she held until September, she died on her daughters birthday in 2017.

I took over the job of Ringmaster from then where I find the job challenging and worthwhile. SA's since 1996 except for the ones cancelled due to New Castle and Covid19, the SA's are the best part of the hobby is here you meet your fellow members and friends you have made over the years. I at least got to see parts of SA from Cape Town to Nelspruit and Durban but today the travelling and accommodation has become to expensive but being held in Bloemfontein does help a bit.

The electronic world of today is slowly destroying our hobby, the kids of today do not have hobby's except their phones, moms and dads do not encourage kids to take up a hobby of some sort.

I just want to conclude with this message" just keep on breeding and promoting the hobby where you can lets try to keep this hobby alive"all for the love of pigeons.

My agtste jaar as Nasionale President is verstreke en daar was heelwat veranderings en aanpassings in die SASV oor die afgelope agt jaar gewees. Ons is nou nogsteeds besig om die gevolge van die Covid-19 pandemie en die uitwerking wat dit op ons ekonomie, ons stokperdjie en ons lede gehad het, te voel.

Ons het gedurende die afgelope jaar ook verskeie lede, oudlede en familie van lede aan die dood afgestaan. Ons gebede was by almal en ons dink aan hul geliefdes wat agtergebly het. Ek wil graag een persoon uitsonder en dit is Attie van Aswegen. Ten

Met die 2022 SA's te Malmesbury het die Uitvoerende Komitee 'n werkskomitee saamgestel om die moontlikheid van 'n sentrale SA Kampioenskapskou in Bloemfontein te ondersoek. Die gevolg daarvan is dat ons dié jaar ons tweede sentrale

tye van sy dood het hy op die Uitvoerende Komitee gedien as Nasionale Jeugvertegenwoordiger. Attie het diep spore onder die jeug van die SASV en Nasionale Jeugskoue getrap, wat moeilik gevul sal word. Daar is ook baie lede wat siek is en ons hou hulle in ons gebede en bid vir 'n spoedige herstel.

Ons ledetal aan die einde van Desember 2023 was 179 wat 17 minder was as 2022 se 196 lede. Dit is 'n negatiewe groei in ledetal van -8.7% teenoor verlede jaar se negatiewe groei van -8%. Op die 17de Junie 2024 was ons ledetal reeds 187, maar dit is egter nog baie laag en die Uitvoerende Komitee is besig om na maniere en reklame te kyk om meer lede vir die SASV te werf. Die Streek wat persentasie gewys die meeste groei getoon het is Wes-Transvaal met 38% wat drie (3) lede verteenwoordig, gevolg deur KwaZulu Natal met 22% wat twee (2) lede verteenwoordig, Noord-Kaap met 20% wat drie (3) lede verteenwoordig, Suid-Westelike Distrikte met 17% wat een (1) lid verteenwoordig en Wes-Kaap met 4% wat een (1) lid verteenwoordig. Ons moet die manne en vroue daar gelukwens met wat hulle reggekry het. Ongelukkig het al die ander streke 'n daling in lede-getalle getoon.

Suid Afrikaanse Kampioenskapskou in Bloemfontein aanbied. Wat hierdie Kampioenskapskou nog meer spesiaal maak is die feit dat dit ons 75ste Kampioenskapskou is en die eerste wat deur die Uitvoerende Komitee self aangebied word en nie

deur `n Streek nie.

`n Skoubestuur is deur die Uitvoerende Komitee aangewys om die 2024 Kampioenskapskou namens hulle aan te bied. Onder leiding van Shaun Smeda met sy span, te wete Leendert Snyman, Phillip Lee, Sevanah de Bruin, Awie, Daleen en Marleen Esterhuizen, Ds. Hennie en Ronè Hattingh, Hendri Botha, Bertie Wessels en Chris de Bruin, het hulle vir ons die SA`s aanmekeer geslaan wat ons die afgelope drie dae geniet het. Ons kan hulle gerus `n welverdiende klop op die skouer gee.

Oor die algemeen was ons skoue hierdie jaar kleiner as vorige jare, deels oor die knypende ekonomie wat tot gevolg het dat lede minder duive aanhou en ook minder duive skou of minder skoue bywoon. Die uitbreek van siektes in sommige lede se hokke het hierdie teelseisoen ook baie vrektes tot gevolg gehad en het ook veroorsaak dat baie lede hierdie jaar minder of geen skoue bygewoon het nie.

Ek het gedurende hierdie jaar se skouseisoen vyf Streekskoue, te wete Noord- Kaap -, Oostelike Streek -, Noord van die Vaal -, Wes-Transvaal – en Kwazulu-Natal Streekskoue en twee Jong Duifskoue, te wete Noord-Vrystaat – en Wes-Transvaal se Jong Duifskoue bygewoon. Het op vier van die skoue as Hoof Beoordelaar opgetree. Ek is van mening dat die toekoms vir Streek – en Jongduifskoue daarin lê dat ons lede meer van saamry geleenthede of klubs gebruik moet maak om skoue by te woon en dat ons ook jaarliks sekere skoue moet teiken vir bywoning. Noord van die Vaal en KwaZulu Natal het reeds gewys dat dit kan werk.

In 2023 was daar 5 274 duive geskou en gedurende 2024 was daar 4 993 duive geskou (281 minder) ingesluit die huidige SA`s in Bloemfontein. Daar is hierdie jaar `n geringe afname in die aantal duive wat geskou was in vergelyking met 2023. Die waarneming was dat lede wat altyd groot getalle duive geskou het oor die algemeen hierdie jaar minder duive ingeskryf het as vorige jare. Die

huidige SA`s in Bloemfontein het net minder as verlede jaar se aantal duive (1 155 teenoor 1 347, dit wil sê 192 minder) en die getal vertoners het ook verminder van 72 na 65. Dit is egter nogsteeds amper meer as dubbel wat ons in 2022 in Malmesbury gehad het, te wete 663 duive vertoon deur 33 lede. Ek dink dit is `n aanduiding vir ons dat die sentrale SA Kampioenskapskou die pad is wat ons in die toekoms moet oorweeg. Getalle duive vertoon by die skoue was oor die algemeen minder as verlede jaar, maar ek dink onder die huidige ekonomiese omstandighede waarin ons tans verkeer is dit nie sleg nie.

Gedurende 2024 is daar 88 verskillende rasse geskou teenoor 2023 waar daar 92 rasse geskou was. Van die 164 rasse op ons stelsels, is daar in 2024, 76 rasse waarin geen duive geskou was nie teenoor 2023 se 72 rasse waarin geen duive geskou was nie. Ek wonder in hoeveel van hierdie rasse is daar nog duive in Suid Afrika beskikbaar? In 2024 is daar 22 rasse waarin daar `n totaal van minder as 10 duive geskou was teenoor die 24 rasse in 2023.

Die Top Tien Rasse geskou vir 2024 is as volg:

1. Mookees 420 (Verlede jaar 2de met 366)
2. Waaiersterte 368 (Nuu in top tien, verlede jaar 15de met 99. As ek reg is, was die vorige jaar se Spesklubskou totaal nie hierby ingesluit nie.)
3. Sjinese Uile 289 (Verlede jaar 1ste met 490)
4. American Show Racers 289 (Verlede jaar 8ste met 208)
5. Modenas Schietti Gemerk 253 (Verlede jaar 3de met 303)
6. Birmingham Rollers 217 (Verlede jaar 6de met 245)
7. Working Homers 215 (Verlede jaar 5de met 246)
8. Brunners 168 (Verlede jaar 4de met 257)
9. Portuguese Tumblers 163 (Verlede jaar 9de met 164)
10. Old German Owls 145 (Verlede jaar 10de met 152)
10. German Beauty Homers 117 (Nuu in top tien,

verlede jaar 12de met 110)

Geluk aan die lede wat met die top tien rasse teel en wat tot die prestasie bygedra het. Die Mookees, Waaiersterte, American Show Racers en German Beauty Homers is die enigste top tien rasse wat 'n groei in getalle getoon het met meer duive wat in 2024 vertoon is. Die Waaiersterte het die grootste groei getoon met 269 meer duive vertoon. Die Waaiersterte en German Beauty Homers het opgeskuif in die top tien rasse in en die Holle Cropers het uitgeval.

Die SASV het 'n groot tekort aan Beoordelaars en ek wil 'n beroep op ons lede doen om hulself as Beoordelaars te bekwaam. Dankie vir die lede wat deur die jaar op verskillende skoue vir Beoordelaars getoets het. Dit sal die druk op ons huidige Beoordelaars baie verlig. Sosiale media het dit moontlik gemaak vir ons lede om vinniger skou-uitslae en foto's te versprei en dan is daar ongelukkig ook lede wat negatiewe kommentaar op die foto's lewer. Ons moet onthou dat foto's net 'n oomblik vasvang en nie werklik die kwaliteit van die spesifieke duif wys nie. Daar is 'n groot verskil tussen, om 'n duif in die hand te beoordeel of op 'n foto te sien en ons moet dit besef en ingedagte hou voor ons kommentaar op foto's lewer.

Die Spesklubs wat die Uitvoerende Komitee in Februarie 2023 dormant verklaar en hul bates in trust geplaas het, te wete die Bodemtuimelaars, Sjinese Uile, Kleurduive, Modanesers, SA Tuimelaars, Old German Owls, Skaarsrasse, Swaarrasse, Strassers en Trompetters & Toys, is steeds dormant. Die

Old German Owls en Sjinese Uile het intussen by die Uil en Strikduifklub ingeskakel en hul bates is oorgedra na die nuwe Spesklub toe.

Die Waaierstert, Indiese Waaierstert, Mookee, Engelse Long Face Tuimelaar en Uil en Strikduif telers het aktiewe WhatsApp-groepe wat hulle bedryf en hul rasse word werklik daardeur bevorder. Die SASV moet ook begin kyk hoe ons sosiale media tot ons voordeel en bevordering van ons doelwitte kan gebruik. Hier wil ek vir Johan van Eeden en Rodney Stevens bedank en gelukwens met die SA Fancy Pigeon WhatsApp groep wat hulle privaat bedryf. Dit doen baie goed vir ons stokperdjie en ons het al verskeie lede deur die groep gewerf.

Hierdie was ook weereens 'n onstuimige jaar wat baie onderstroming in die SASV blootgelê het. Ek wil 'n ernstige beroep op ons lede doen dat ons meer verdraagsaam teenoor mekaar sal wees en net by die reëls sal hou. Dit is elke lid se eie verantwoordelikheid om op hoogte te wees van wat die SASV se reëls behels en wat toelaatbaar is.

Laat ons al die onaangename dinge agter ons sit en met nuwe positiwiteit die leisels vat en 2025 'n beter jaar maak. Mag die nuwe jaar vir almal net mooi en opwindende dinge inhou. Onthou jou familie, vriende en duive is kosbaar.

Na n hele paar jaar het ek besluit om weer die pen op te tel en ietsie te skryf en wat kan dan nou lekkerder wees as om te skryf oor Modenas en Genetika!

Daar is n tyd terug baie rondgevra op ons Modena Spes Klub groep oor Reduce Modenas in Suid-Afrika en orals is gesoek, maar tot ons spyt het ons besef dat die Reduce faktor op ons Modenas uitgesterf het!

Ek het Reduce op Saddle Homers vir jare geteel omdat dit so mooi is EN om hulle as feeders vir my Modenas te gebruik, Zandri Erasmus het van die begin af gesit aan my ek moet Reduce terug sit op ons Modenas, maar my verskoning was maar altyd dit gaan te veel jare vat EN ek het die faktor op ‘n ras wat 10 white flights het!! Iets waarvan ons nie hou op ‘n Modena nie LOL

Zandri wou egter nie ophou nie en op die end het sy wragtag ‘n Reduce vliegduif cock iewers gekoop en gekruis met ‘n swart Schietti Modena hen. Hier op ‘n dag, vroeg in 2022 laat weet sy my – “ek stuur vir jou ‘n F1 Reduce hen” “Ja jy gaan vir ons Reduce op die Modenas sit” .... en so het alles begin.... - As die Pa reduce is en die Ma swart = gaan jy reduce dogters teel en die seuns gaan die reduce faktor dra.
- As die Pa reduce faktor dra en die Ma is swart = gaan jy ook reduce dogters teel, maar nou gaan van die seuns die reduce dra en van hulle nie. (Slegs deur toets parings later sal jy weet wie van hulle dra reduce en wie nie)
- As jy reduce cocke wil teel – Moet die pa reduce dra Of reduce wees en die ma moet ook reduce wees.

Net so ietsie oor die geskiedenis van die Reduce mutasie – dit was destyds deur Carl Graefe ontdek op 'n Roller, iewers in Amerika, en so met die jare is dit oorgedra op ander rasse.

So in my geval was die F1 crossing 'n reduce hen. Met my geluk teel ek toe net een swart cock daai hele jaar van 2022!! Dis nou 'n F2 crossing. In 2023 somer my 1ste broei met hom by my beste swart Modena hen teel ek 'n Reduce hen (F3) en wraggies nooit weer nie! Die geluk met die ongeluk soos hulle sê.

So dit bring ons nou by 2024 waar als weer van voor begin! Nou word die beste tipe swart Schietti Modena cock weer op daai F3 Reduce hennetjie gesit, Dan gaan die nageslag almal weer swart wees, maar slegs die seuns (F4) kan gebruik word omdat slegs hulle die Reduce faktor dra, Lekker lang proses né? So in 2025, as die geluk aan my kant is, sal F5 Reduce hennetjie weer te voorskyn kom en ek glo hulle gaan darem nóg meer na 'n

Modena lyk.

Sodra die tipe eers meer Modena is sal ek begin om 'n split Reduce cock terug te sit op 'n Reduce hen om sodoende Reduce cocke te teel, maar dit gaan nog laaaaank vat glo ek. Ek het egter klaar van die "baster" duiwe aangepaas na ander telers, want sê nou net iets gebeur in my hok!?? Dan is alles verlore in 'n oogwink. **About the Schmalkalden Moorheads:**

**From internet Submitted by Jan Lombard**

"These Mohrenköpfe were not the first and not the last colored pigeons produced by Thuringian breeders, but they were certainly one of their best."

This is how Edmund Zurth describes it in his book on colored pigeons. One can only agree with this statement. There are many myths surrounding the development of the Schmalkalden Mohrenkopf. Firstly, that the ship's doctor Dr. Binder brought the breed from the Urals and secondly, that two breeders bred the Schmalkalden Mohrenkopf in Schmalkalden between 1880 and 1890. These breeders were called Emil Schweizer and Julius Liebaug. In the brochure that Heini Beier published for the 100th anniversary of the Schmalkalden poultry breeding association in 1993, the breeding of the Schmalkalden Mohrenkopf by these two breeders is documented. Unfortunately, the "curly Mohrenkopf" or "Schmalkaldener" was already being reported before 1890. For example, in Gustav Prütz's "Illustrated Pattern Pigeon Book" from 1886 or in

"The Types of Domestic Pigeons" from 1871. The breed was described for the first time in 1855.

In an article from June 19, 1896, the alleged breeder Julius Liebaug from Schmalkalden wrote that the Mohrenkopf had already existed in his parents' and grandparents' time. Unfortunately, most of the breeds were in Saxony. Therefore, the two breeders Liebaug and Schweizer set about making the Schmalkalden Mohrenkopf native to Schmalkalden again.

The breed experienced its first heyday at the turn of the century. Old records show that immense sums were paid for the Schmalkaldener Mohrenkopf. But the two world wars did not spare our breed either. In the period of recession and high unemployment, the big sell-off began, which meant that the breed went quiet again. Two breeders from the old federal states held the flag of the Schmalkaldener Mohrenkopf high. In Saxony it was breeding friend Pester from Limbach-Oberfrohna and there were others who did not appear in the public eye.

In the beginning there were only black Schmalkaldener Mohrenköpfe. In the mid-1950s, breeder Höpfner from Arnstadt started breeding the red, yellow and blue Schmalkaldener Mohrenköpfe. It took a long time until color and structure were combined in one pigeon. "And in doing so he gave his pigeon breeding home of Thuringia another jewel of German pigeon breeding." In 1986 the colored Mohrenköpfe were recognized on the West German side at the VDT show in Offenbach.

In the 1930s, there was a special club for the breed for the first time. Until the Second World War, there were three special clubs that looked after the Schmalkaldener Mohrenkopf with more or less success. After that, the breed was looked after in the East until the fall of the Berlin Wall in the special breeding association for rare colored pigeons, and in the West until 1977 in the special club for Saxon colored pigeons. In 1977, the breed was separated and an independent special club was founded. After the fall of the Berlin Wall, breeders from the new federal states joined the special club for Schmalkaldener Mohrenköpfe in 1977. This made the Schmalkaldener Mohrenkopf a structural pigeon throughout Germany.

This led to a great upswing in the breed. In 1993, on the 100th anniversary of the Schmalkalden poultry breeding association, there were over 150 Schmalkalden Mohrenköpfe in the exhibition cages. Today, the number of entries has settled at between 100 and 120. The special association now has 36 members from several European countries.

What can be said about the current breeding status of the breed? Since there are no longer any problems with breeding and keeping, a strong field pigeon shape can be expected as a matter of course. A horizontal and low stance - with a nice neck length - characterizes the appearance. The structure is of course the most important requirement. It is divided into the crest, chain and mane. Clear visibility must be guaranteed.

The black color has always been the leading color, but the other three are hot on its heels.

The red Schmalkaldener Mohrenköpfe are a very difficult undertaking. There are still some deficits in the color and the beak color. With yellow we have large, strong animals with rich color. Our problem child is the blue Schmalkaldener Mohrenköpfe. There are top animals - but very few. They have problems with the color and the end of the tail bar.

But let's not forget - we are dealing with a structural pigeon! What use is the best color if the structure is loose, the hat is lying flat and the chain is open?

At the moment I am not worried about the future of the Schmalkaldener Mohrenkopf, but it still needs new and, above all, persistent breeders!

## ***How to judge a German Modeneser***

**Submitted by

### **Type & station = most important**

German Modeneser is the smallest and most moderate breed of the Hen Pigeon group. This fact alone emphasizes the importance of the correct type combined with the correct station. How should the type be?

Here one should distinguish between two aspects:

#### **a) elegance and b) correct ratios.**

When the elegance mentioned under a) is disregarded in striving for longer necks and legs, it easily gets lost. Although a cock is naturally more masculine than a hen, the overall impression that it is big or coarse should never be created. The first hint to a breeder or judge that a German Modena is too coarse, is when the band sits too tight on the leg. Even though a specific rings size per breed is no longer required as long as the ring cannot be removed, a 7mm (A size) ring is a must to guarantee elegance.

The neck should be long and slender, but never shorter or longer than the legs. Even though a cock will naturally have a heavier neck than a hen, and as a result of a temperament of the breed likes to blow itself up a bit, this should never be exces-

sive. Currently a slightly heavier neck is accepted to ensure a fuller and better rounded head, as a thinner and more slender neck leads to a snipey narrow head. The throat should be cut-out well and the neck should be tight feathered. With such tight feathers the neck will look more slender. One should however take into account that white feathers will never be as tight as coloured feathers.

The wings should be carried close to the body and may not cross. Wings that hang below the tail are not acceptable and should result in 91 points at the most. The body should feel solid and strong, a crooked keel is a disqualification. The underline of a German Modeneser is also important. Seen in profile, this should form an uninterrupted curve from neck to tail. To achieve this, the bird should have enough chest depth. Loose feathers behind the legs often break this curve (double decker).

The ratios mentioned under b) determine the correct type of the German Modena. This makes or breaks the breed! We have to do with the most moderate of the Hen Pigeons when it comes to type. Extremities in neck and leg length are not wanted and destroy the required elegance. The correct ratio for type is: length to Height = 2:3. The statement: "The longer the neck and legs, the better" is wrong. The height of a German Modeneser consists out of three equal parts: neck length = body depth = length of legs.

Length should be 2/3's of height. This is not always achieved. Many German Modenas have slightly long backs, which disturbs the ratios. Breeders try

to address this with longer legs and necks, but when these are equal in length, realise that the backs are too long, and not that the necks or legs too short. To achieve the correct length the tail should not be too long, but short and narrow. Birds that excel in these ratios often fall short in not having enough depth of chest. In judging however elegance and the correct ratios are more important than an uninterrupted underline. A bird without enough depth of chest should not score more than 93. One should however keep in mind that tight feathering do not enhance a deep chest and set moderate demands in this regard.

The order of importance when judging type is therefore:

- 1 Ratios in height
- 2 Ratios in length
- 3 Elegance
- 4 Close / tight feathering
- 5 Underline and width of chest

Width of chest mention under 5 has not yet been discussed. The chest may not be narrow. The wing bows should be covered well.

### The Station

The second point, closely related to type, is the station of a German Modeneser. This should be absolutely horizontal, with the tail slightly higher. There should not be deviated from this. If you mentioned "sloping station" on the pen card, you can give only one final judgement – 90 points. The bird should be given a fair opportunity to show itself, as a sloping station is not common. A sign of a purebred German



Modeneser, is when it stations on its toes. Judges should look out for this. Legs form part of station. These should be clean – without any feathers and red in colour.



The tail is carried too high, with loose feathering below the vent.



The demarcation of the head is not clear; the neck feathers is too loose; lacking chest and chest depth.



Not enough frontal, bib too low, feathers on legs not smooth, shallow station.

Over extended knee joints, X- (knock-kneed) or O-legs (“bak bene”) is good for only 90 points. Even straight legs (with no angle between the featherless and feathered part) should receive attention. The last important point in judging station is how the tail is carried. This should be slightly above the horizontal. Often it is carried too high, which is mostly linked to a back that is too short. It is mainly the scarce colours that are plagued by this. The tail should never be broad or loose. Such a bird is not fit for the show bench.

The most common deviation in type and station are:

- coarse in build, lack of elegance
- short neck or short legs
- long back
- thick neck
- tail carried too high
- shallow and narrow chest
- loose plumage

### The Head

The head is very important when judging the German Modeneser. The head always should be properly observed in the judging pen. A clear distinction should be made between cocks and hens. The head should follow a curved line from the base of the beak to the neck, with a blunt angle at the beak. The highest point should be above the eye. The frontal should be well filled. “Stirn” in the German language.

The frontal should be slightly protruding from the base of the beak. This indicates purity. The base of the beak should be wide enough. The head should not be stretched out too much – i.e. too much back skull. This is a common fault. Keep in mind during judging that a cock has a fuller and rounder head than a hen. If this is not the case, the cock's head is either too snipey, or the hen is excellent. On average Gazzi's have better heads than Schietti's, and as a result they have thicker necks. Scarce colours mostly have poor snipey heads.

Pigeons with coarse heads should be penalised. The maximum possible score should then be 93 points. The ideal is heads that are not too long or

powerful. The head should not be “hanging”, but position so that the frontal is displayed correctly. Lastly one should look for a well cut out throat, since a throat that is too full results in a coarse head.

The most common head faults are:

- Flat head
- Snipey narrow frontal
- Too much back skull
- Too narrow at the base of the beak

### Eye Colour

High demands are set for eye colour. This should be orange-red, but then as much as possible to fiery red, almost “uitspringen”. In the strongest colours like blue Gazzi and Black Schietti eye colour is even more important. Yellowy eyes should cost a few points. Any deviation in the pupil and any “vlek-ke” of the iris should lead to 90 points. The same should happen if the colour of the two eyes differ – i.e. one eye being redder than the other.



In certain colours there should be an exception of these strict rules. Since red and yellow pigmented pigeons have lighter eyes, the rule should be: the redder the better. Long discussions over eye colour resulted in Silver Dun and Russert-tri being less popular. These colours cannot genetically have orange-red eyes. There will always be a white inner circle present, resulting a so-called false pearl eye colour associated with brown pigmented pigeons. The only other exception to the rule is whites with bull eyes

### Eye Ceres

Eye ceres follow onto eye colour. This can be described as almost invisible, it goes hand-in-hand with feather colour and is narrow and fine. Being almost invisible is very important in the top colours. In Black Schietti the eye ceres should be absolute black. The lightest indication of lighter colour or open eye ceres, should be dealt with severely. Judging of the eye cere should take place while

the bird is in the pen. When taken into the hand, the bird will pull its feathers closer, which will make the eye ceres more prominent. Any indication of reddish eye ceres should be heavily penalised. It should be taken into account that red and yellow birds have lighter eye ceres that are more visible. Coarse eye ceres makes a German Modeneser unfit for the show bench. Whites with bull eyes is the only exception, as they should have red eye ceres.

### Color variations

To discuss all colours in detail is an impossible task. To determine if a colour is recognised or not, we refer you to the list below, which corresponds with the list in the German standard. The most popular colours in Holland & Belgium will be discussed elsewhere on the website. High demands are set for colour quality and dull colours are not acceptable.

Clear demarcation between white and colour is required in Gazzi. In the head this is not normally problematic, but trimming should never be visible. The most common fault is that the white reaches up to far at the back of the head, and the bibs reaches to low below the beak.

Coloured feathers in the white parts and white feathers in the coloured parts is good for a total score of 91 points only. The tail should be sharply demarcated – on the back as well as below the vent. Gazzi's often have coloured feathers on their legs, which is clearly visible in darker coloured pigeons, especially blacks. If not too prominent, these “socks” are accepted. In Gazzis the back should be white, except for the little “bridge” between the wings, which should never deteriorate into a richly coloured back. Enough white space should be left between the “bridge” and the tail. Toe nail colour matches feather colour, BUT is of no significance in the show value of the bird. This means that a Black Gazzi will have black toe nails, but if one or a few are white, the bird can still score 97 points.

For the breeder the appearance of white toenails is the first sign of loss of pigment, which should be guarded against in his breeding program. The beak colour also follows the feather colour and is very important. In colours where a dark beak is required, a light spot will make the bird unsuitable for showing.

In total there are 74 recognised colours in the German Modena, which you will find ordered by category in the list below.

Jan Lombard note: With all the colour genes, pattern genes, spread gene and modifiers already available in this list of 72 colours, the knowledgeable breeder will be able to breed a lot more colours. You will for instance notice blue Grizzle below. This can be bred with bronze bars or black bars. There is a mealy Grizzle listed, but no Silver Grizzle, Cream bar, Brown bar or Khaki bar Grizzle. Although Andalusian is listed, no provision is made for barless (no tail bar), barred or checked Indigos in either Gazzi or Schietti. The list contains Black, but not Dun, Silverdun, but not Spread Brown or Khaki etc. Any such possible, but not recognised colours should be entered in the any other colour (A.O.C.) class. When the new show schedule is produce I propose that we have 10 classes as follows:

Any standard blue; Any Standard ash red; Any standard Brown, Any Other Standard Colour and Any Other Colour for both Gazzi and Schietti. With the birds I have imported I will soon be able to show all three basic colours in 3 patterns (barless, bar and check) in either intense or dilute; with or without Grizzle; in either Gazzi or Schietti. What is still missing (in 2014) are: recessive red, Indigo, Ice, Spread, and Toy Stencil genes for Argents.

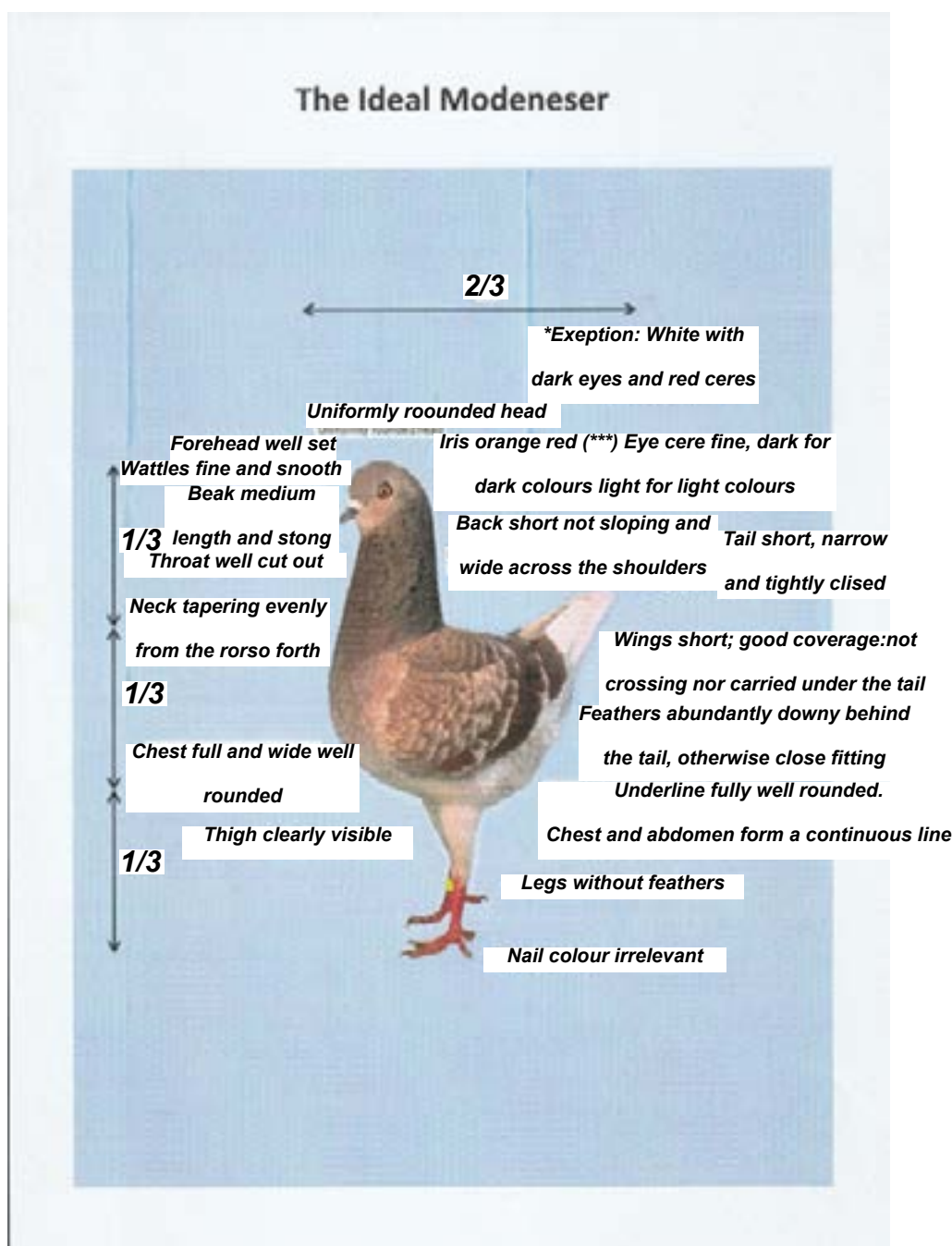
